- ➤ <u>Budget Committee</u> Responsibilities include assisting the City Council in the examination and analyzing of proposed budgets for the City of Keizer. State statute requires volunteers serving on the Budget Committee to BE KEIZER CITIZEN REGISTERED VOTERS. The Budget Committee meets in May of each year to review the annual budget. (TWO OPEN POSITIONS)

- ➤ Planning Commission The Commission assists the City Council in land use decisions and recommendations regarding Keizer's future growth, development, and beautification. The Commission meets on the second Wednesday of the month at 6:00 p.m. The Planning Commission has guidelines for composition and organization. The guidelines prohibit more than two members to be engaged principally in the buying, selling, or developing of real estate. In addition, Planning Commission members are required to file a statement of economic interest disclosure form with the Oregon Government Ethics Commission. (TWO OPEN POSITIONS)

- ➤ <u>Public Art Commission</u> This Commission reviews, evaluates, selects, maintains, and documents all artwork, public art, and public murals within the city. The Commission may advise the City Council and City Manager on the management, execution, installation, or placement of the artwork, public art and public murals and will recommend guidelines for adoption by the City Council for the selection and placement of the artwork giving preference to Oregon artists. The Commission meets on the third Tuesday of every other month at 6:00 p.m. (ONE OPEN POSITION)

- Parks Advisory Board This Board reviews and studies issues that involve development and maintenance of city parks and makes recommendations to the Council. The Board meets on the second Tuesday of each month at 6:00 p.m. (ONE OPEN POSITION)

- ➤ Youth Councilor The position of Youth Councilor will be filled by a student selected through an application and selection process overseen by the Volunteer Coordinating Committee. The Youth Councilor position is available to sophomore and junior year students who will serve during their junior or senior year of High School respectively.
